

Comparison between the Fund Return and the Benchmark Return

Fund Performance Chart



Since the start date in the Provident Fund Scheme, cumulatively **underperform** benchmark by **13.71 percentage points**

The benchmark increased by 71.60% during 10/05/2010 to 31/05/2015 while the active fund – Schroder only rose by 57.89% during the same period.

The fund has been in the Provident Fund Scheme since 10/05/2010, its cumulative performance is calculated net of the total annual fees of the Provident Fund Scheme.
