
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Comparison between the Fund Return and the Benchmark Return

Since the start date in the Provident Fund Scheme, cumulatively underperform benchmark by 19.02 percentage points

The benchmark increased by 70.88% during 10/05/2010 to 30/09/2016 while the active fund – Schroder only rose by 51.86% during the same period.

The Fund has been in the Provident Fund Scheme since 10/05/2010, its cumulative performance is calculated net of the total annual fees of the Provident Fund Scheme.
